### HOUSE VOTE (HB71) TURNS CLOCK BACK ON RACE RELATIONS IN LOUISIANA

**Baton Rouge, Louisiana.** Today the House of Representatives voted to usurp local government authority and decision making power. It was done under the guise of celebrating war heroes, but exposed a deep-rooted belief in White supremacy and racial divisiveness.
